## 3 Function and Parameter

## 3.1 Functional Overview

Gree BACnet gateway ME30-44/D2(B) for multi VRF unit can realize data exchange between air conditioner and BMS system and provide building interfaces for standard BACnet/IP.Applicable models for this gateway are listed in Attachment B.

The following BACnet protocol gateway ME30-44/D2(B) is shorted as gateway.

## 3.2 Parameter Specifications

### 3.2.1 Gateway TCP/IP Parameter (Default)

IP Address:192.168.0.200

Subnet Mask:255.255.255.0

Default gateway:192.168.0.1

**CAUTION:** After the TCP/IP parameters are altered, the gateway should be restarted, then the parameters can come into effect.

## 5 Introduction for Gateway

## 5.1 Interface

### 5.1.1 Diagram of Interface Function




Fig. 5.1 Schematic of protocol gateway interfaces of multi VRF unit

### 5.1.2 Power

The input power supply is 24V DC, there are two power supply input interfaces, only one is needed during operation; the power supply output is not applicable in this device, please do not connect to electric appliance, otherwise it may cause malfunction of gateway.

### 5.1.3 Communication Interface

CAN comm port: this device will not use this communication interface temporarily.

RS485-1 comm port: connect to the unit(s) or the connection between adjacent gateways.

RS485-2 comm port: this device will not use this communication interface temporarily.

USB and SD card port: this device will not use this interface temporarily.

Ethernet comm port ETH0: realize communication through network cable and

BMS.

Ethernet comm port CONFIG: this device will not use this interface temporarily.

## 5.2 LED Display

As shown in the picture below, open the black transparent front panel.




Fig 5.2 Schematic diagram of opening the black transparent board Indicators, buttons and DIP switch are as shown below.




Fig 5.3 The schematic diagram of the gateway LED light board and DIP switch

The above LED indicator is mainly consist of two parts: status indicator (run, power) and communication indicator (CAN and RS485). The following table is the working status of each indicator.

0.4.14	RX	This device does not use this LED indicator.		
CAN	ΤХ	This device does not use this LED indicator.		
D04054	RX	When the gateway receives data on the 485 bus, it blinks.		
RS485-1	ΤХ	When the gateway sends data to the 485 bus, it blinks.

STAT		When power supply of Gateway is normal, it is on.

### 5.3 Button

SHT/DWN	Hold the button for 5s and all indicators will be on; the gateway will be reset and restarted.
BACKUP	Not use this button for this device temporarily.


## 5.4 DIP Switch

## **NOTICE!**

Before using this device, please conduct DIP switch setting first, otherwise the unit will not function normally!

Gateway dial-up setting area is consisting of function DIP switch code.

# 5.4.2 The 2st Lever of Functional DIP Switch—485 Bus Matched Resistance Setting

The 2nd dial code of the function dialer is used for setting the matching resistance of the gateway of 485 bus.

When the controller is at the beginning/end of the 485 bus, the controller needs to be set to be with matching resistance, then the second bit of function dialer is set to 1; when the controller is not at the beginning/end of the 485 bus, set the controller to be without matching resistance, and set the dial code to 0.




Fig. 5.4 Schematic of dial code




Fig. 5.5 Schematic diagram of scenes that should set DIP switch code




Fig. 5.6 Schematic diagram of scenes that no need to set DIP switch code

# 6 Application

## 6.1 Building Management System (BMS)

This gateway has provided BACnet standard protocols, which can connect to building management system (BMS). It can monitor RS485 protocol Gree unit by Building Management System through the gateway.

## 6.2 Internet Topological Graph




Fig. 6.1 Communication network topology

Network topology instruction::

**485 bus**: 485 bus: The wire indicated by L2 in fig, 6.1 is 485 bus. One 485 bus can connect 255 units at the most.

**Cable:** The wire indicated by L2 in fig. 6.2 is the normal cable. The gateway can be connected to BMS by the cable.

Units' quantity that can be connected to the gateway: One gateway can connect 255 units at the most.

# 7 Product Installation

# 7.1 Product Size and Spatial Size for Electric Control Cabinet Installation

## 7.1.1 Product Size




Fig. 7.1 Gateway product size chart

Notice for installation and operation:

- (1) Ensure the specification of power input. Otherwise, Gateway can't work normally or even be damaged.
- (2) Ensure the dial code setting of Gateway is correct. Otherwise, there will be communication malfunction.
- (3) Ensure that the communication cord has connected to the correct interface. Otherwise, there will be communication malfunction.
- (4) Do not place Gateway in direct sunlight or high-temperature and humid environment. Place it in the central control cabinet.

### 7.1.2 Spatial Size for Electric Control Cabinet Installation

Gateway shall be installed in electric control cabinet; the front of gateway shall be hung upward and fixed with 4 screws. See the following fig (for reference).




Fig. 7.2 Gateway installation guide

**WARNING!** Power cord and communication line of Gateway must conduct routing separately (the distance shall be over 15cm); otherwise, it might lead to Gateway communication malfunction!

The thin real line shown in the figure is communication wire and weak current wire, the thick real line is strong current wire. Above lines are only for reference.

## 7.2 Gateway and BMS Communication Connecting Method


### 7.2.1 Material Selection for Communication line


- (1) Model selection of Gateway and BMS communication line shall use standard Ethernet communication line, the length of network cable between gateway and router (computer, switchboard, etc.) shall not exceed 80m
- (2) Communication line model selection for Gateway and AC unit




Fig. 7.4 Connecting method of gateway


**(NOTICE!** All communication connection lines under Gateway must be in series connection, star connection shall not be adopted.


### 7.2.3 Communication Connection Configuration






Fig. 7.6 Gateway connects to personal computer via router

(3) Gateway configuration:

One gateway can connect 255 units at the same time. After installation, the parameters of gateway should be set. Before setting the parameters of gateway, please set the IP address of PC as the same with the IP address in the same network segment of gateway, as refer to appendix A; and then open the browser (IE10 and above version, Firefox or Google), input the default IP address of gateway: http://192.168.0.200, default user name: admin, password: 123456; as shown below.




Fig. 7.8 Schematic diagram of "PRI" button

Parameters that can be set: gateway IP address (IP address setting: numbers of master unit can't all be 0; if they are all 0, it indicates the whole network, such as 192.168.0.0; numbers of master unit can't all be 1; if they are all 1, it indicates broadcast address, such as 192.168.0.255. It is not suggested to be set by users. Otherwise, the gateway pages will unable to access), Gateway subnet mask, defaulted gateway,device name and device ID. Users can configurate it by themselves according to actual circumstances.

Default parameters:

- ① Access platform:Third-party;
- 2 Access protocol:BACnet IP;
- ③ Communication port :47808;
- ④ OutTime:1000(ms).

After the parameter setting is completed, click Save and restart the gateway to complete the configuration.

QCaution! The default parameters should not be changed. Otherwise, the gateway may not work normally.

## 8 Attachment A TCP/IP Setting

This text takes Windows 10 as example to demonstrate the setting of TCP/IP.

- (1) Left click the icon "Start" and on the computer. When a new window pops up, left click "Settings" to enter "Windows Settings".
